

Guidelines for Online Learning Classes within the Lowndes County School System

Purpose of Online Learning Opportunity for Lowndes County Students:

The Lowndes County School System recognizes the importance of our students becoming independent, life-long learners, and one aspect of this goal is allowing students to work through classes in an online environment. Recognizing that the business community, colleges, and universities seek graduates whose high level digital skills match their ongoing professional and learning needs, the school system offers online classes as an option for disciplined, self-motivated students who desire this technological platform for learning.

In compliance with Senate Bill 289, online courses for the Lowndes County School System can be accessed through Georgia Virtual School. The rigor of the Georgia Virtual School (GAVS) courses mirrors the high level of expectation students are held to within the Lowndes County School System. Interested parents or students should meet with the school guidance counselor for more information. Requests for courses through other online vendors must be evaluated on an individual basis. See your guidance counselor prior to registering for consideration of credit. Only courses taken through Georgia Virtual School (or another online provider contracted by the Lowndes County School System) will be funded by the Lowndes County School System.

<u>To participate in part-time enrollment</u> for Georgia Virtual School during the 2021-2022 school year, students must register with a guidance counselor between April 26 - May 1. Students are required to meet with a school guidance counselor or Mrs. Dickey (Assistant Principal and GAVS Facilitator) prior to enrollment in Georgia Virtual School.

<u>To participate in full-time enrollment</u> for Georgia Virtual School during the 2021 school year, students must register with a guidance counselor no later than June 30, 2021. Students are required to meet with a school guidance counselor or Mrs. Dickey (Assistant Principal and GAVS Facilitator) prior to enrollment in Georgia Virtual School.

Procedures

Recognizing the need for students to be ready for this type of learning, students interested in taking an online course should adhere to these procedures:

- 1. Read the information on the Georgia Virtual School website, www.gavirtualschool.org. Pay close attention to deadlines in the Georgia Virtual School process as well as the list of courses offered. Check this website often, as the information may change as the year progresses.
- 2. Take the technology readiness survey. Print the results to bring when meeting with the school guidance counselor.

- 3. High school students should make an appointment for a meeting with the school guidance counselor or Mrs. Dickey (Assistant Principal and GAVS Facilitator).

 Elementary school students and middle school students should make an appointment for a meeting with the school guidance counselor. Parent attendance at this meeting is mandatory.
- 4. If all parties agree to the Georgia Virtual School arrangement, the Enrollment Agreement is signed, and the student then registers for the Georgia Virtual class.

Other Important Details

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

- 1. The Georgia Virtual School online course can be taken off-campus during the timeframe of first or fourth block. Transportation is the responsibility of the student and/or parent. In addition, there may be a limited number of seats available at the high school for students to take a Georgia Virtual School online course at Lowndes High School during the school day. Students may need to bring their own technology in order to take the course on the high school campus.
- 2. Georgia Virtual School online economics and civics courses are .5 credit courses and do not currently meet graduation requirements for Lowndes County Schools.
- 3. Georgia Virtual School courses will only be allowed to students for courses that are not offered at Lowndes High School.
- 4. The Lowndes County School System stresses the importance of communication with the student's counselor and Mrs. Dickey (Assistant Principal and GAVS Facilitator). Not all courses offered through Georgia Virtual School will meet an individual student's graduation plan.
- 5. Students are required to enroll in a minimum of four classes each fall and spring semester, and the Georgia Virtual online classes can be a part of these four required classes. It is the expectation students will remain enrolled in four classes each fall and spring semester, whether these classes are delivered through the local high school or through Georgia Virtual School.
- 6. Students will not be allowed to enroll in 12-week and 14-week courses.
- 7. Students are encouraged to complete enrollment in Georgia Virtual School well in advance in order to be allowed to register for 18-week courses. Sixteen-week courses are available but increase a student's workload while reducing the amount of time allowed to complete the course. Additionally, 16-week courses do not allow time to withdraw and enroll in courses at Lowndes High School should the student need to withdraw for an **acceptable** reason.
- 8. All students who initially enroll in a Georgia Virtual School online course must complete the online course with Georgia Virtual School. **Students will not be able to drop a GAVS course anytime during the current semester**.
- 9. If the Georgia Virtual School online course is taken in lieu of any of the regular school day instructional periods, the school system will pay for the course. If a Georgia Virtual School online course is chosen in addition to the regular school day instructional



- periods, (beyond four classes in the fall or spring semester), the parent will pay for the course, and additional quality points will not be awarded.
- 10. Requests for courses through other online vendors must be evaluated on an individual basis. See your guidance counselor prior to registering for consideration of credit. Only courses taken through Georgia Virtual School (or another online provider contracted by the Lowndes County School System) will be funded by the Lowndes County School System.

MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS

- 1. Middle school students have the option of participating in appropriate grade-level middle school course offered by Georgia Virtual School. Academic acceleration or academic advancement will not be permitted through Georgia Virtual classes.
- The school will make every reasonable attempt to schedule the Georgia Virtual School class at the beginning or end of the school day. Transportation is the responsibility of the parent/guardian.
- 3. The Lowndes County School System stresses the importance of communication with the student's counselor.
- 4. Students are required to enroll in a minimum of four academic classes each fall and spring semester, and the Georgia Virtual classes students take can be a part of these four required classes. It is the expectation students will remain enrolled in all four classes each fall and spring semester, whether these classes are delivered through the local middle school or through Georgia Virtual School. Students must participate in their home middle school's Connection Program courses.
- 5. All students who initially enroll in a Georgia Virtual School online course must complete the online course with Georgia Virtual School. **Students will not be able to drop a GAVS course anytime during the current semester**.
- 6. If the Georgia Virtual School online course is taken in lieu of any of the regular school day academic courses, the school will pay for the course. If a Georgia Virtual School online course is chosen in addition to the regular school day academic courses, (beyond the four required middle school academic classes in the fall or spring semester), the parent will pay for the course.
- 7. Requests for courses through other online vendors must be evaluated on an individual basis. See your guidance counselor prior to registering for consideration of grade level appropriateness. Only courses taken through Georgia Virtual School (or another online provider contracted by the Lowndes County School System) will be funded by the Lowndes County School System.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL STUDENTS

At this time, there are limited opportunities available for part-time online elementary school options. Please note that the institutions listed are **not** affiliated with Lowndes County School System. If parents choose to enroll their student in a full-time online learning opportunity, the student will no longer be enrolled with Lowndes County Schools. Full-time online elementary school students will not be able to participate in Lowndes County School System's extracurricular and co-curricular activities.
